The Immunisation Practice workshop develops the skills and knowledges required to implement safe immunisation practices in Primary Care, including system and processes, administration of vaccines and development of catch-up schedules.

The face-to-face workshop involves practical activities involving:

- Cold chain management
- Administration of vaccines in a simulated environment
- Practice and assessment (performed on a mannequin)
- Practical assessment conducted during the skills activity session.
