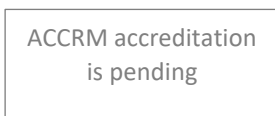

GP Immunisation Update 2023

- Current COVID-19 vaccination booster recommendations
- 2023 influenza vaccination recommendations across the lifespan, including importance for six month to 5 year olds
- NIP adult vaccination – encourage uptake of pneumococcal vaccination for Aboriginal and Non-Indigenous population at appropriate age-points
- Shingles (Zosta or Shinrix) for eligible adult population (catch-up for 71-79 year olds ceases October 2023)
- NSWISS specialized clinical advice for clinicians
