Stroke and Endovascular Clot Retrieval

This session will be an opportunity to meet with Dr Rami Haddad Neurologist and Stroke Director at Orange Health service. Dr Haddad will provide an update on the management process of stroke and eligibility for endovascular clot retrieval. There will be plenty of opportunity for open discussion and Q+A throughout.

Key points for the session will be:

1. Refer patients to Acute stroke Centre when eligible.
2. Prescribe secondary stroke prevention medications.
3. Refer to TIA/Stroke clinic when indicated.
4. Understand follow up process for stroke patients
5. Know about local services and referral pathways to the Stroke/Neurology public clinics.
