<ol> <li>Let your local PHN know that you have applied for the PIP QI Incentive</li> <li>Provide your local PHN with your PIP Practice Identifier</li> <li>Submit the PIP Eligible Data Set to your local PHN on a quarterly basis</li> <li>Work in partnership with your local PHN on practice relevant CQI activities</li> <li>Retain evidence of the CQI activities you have undertaken</li> <li>Sign and return the annual confirmation statement by the due date</li> </ol>

6.	Signed the annual confirmation statement sent by the Department of Human Services in March and return by 31 July each year	
7.	Begun working in partnership with your local PHN on continuous quality improvement activities	
8.	Retained evidence of undertaking continuous quality improvement in partnership with their local PHN
