Initial management

'Red Flag' items

- Re-presentations
- Parental concerns
- Neonates
- Complex medical conditions
- Chronic medical conditions, especially those involving subspecialist care

Note: Paediatric Acute Review Clinic (PARC) has been established to review any children who present to ED and are assessed by paediatric staff as requiring follow-up of the presenting problem, by phone call to parent or review in ward. This clinic operates on an internal referral system and is not accessible to General Practice.
