Indicators for specialist referral

- Macroscopic haematuria
- Recurrent microscopic haematuria

Referral information required

- Duration of haematuria
- Associated pain
- Recent medical / surgical intervention
- e.g. recent catheterisation, radiotherapy
- Current treatment with medications that increase bleeding risk

Investigations required

- Urinalysis +/- MSU
- Ultrasound renal tract or CT IVP
- Urine for cytology x3
- FBC, EUC, INR, PSA
