### Indications for specialist referral

- Symptoms impacting on patient's quality of life

### Referral information required

- History of **storage symptoms**:
- urinary frequency, urgency, nocturia
- History of **voiding symptoms**:
- hesitancy, poor stream, terminal dribbling, sense of incomplete emptying
- History of **complications from LUTS**:
- UTI, haematuria, urinary retention
- Treatment provided to date:
- medications, previous operations

### Investigations required

- MSU
- EUC
- PSA
- Ultrasound renal tract

### Initial management

- Consider trial of oral medications prior to referral: alpha blockers, 5-alpha reductase inhibitors
- Pain relief: indomethacin
- Antibiotics if clinical suspicion of urinary tract infection (commence antibiotics after taking samples of MSU)

### 'Red Flag' items

- Urinary retention
- Haematuria
