# Indications for specialist referral

- Ureteric stones over 3mm or unresponsive to conservative measures
- Renal stones over 5mm

## **Referral information required**

- Size of stone
- Location of stone
- Analgesic requirement if any
- History of diabetes, solitary kidney or renal impairment

#### Investigations required

- CT KUB
- MSU
- UEC

# Initial Management

 Analgesia including NSAIDs and opioids as needed

## 'Red Flag' items

- Fever
- UTI



- Single kidney
- Obstruction with creatinine over 200
