Prostate Cancer

Indications for specialist referral

• PSA elevation or elevating trend. See current Cancer Council guidelines on PSA testing

Referral information required

• Referrals marked 'urgent'

Investigations required

- Two PSAs with minimum 6 week interval (one with free/total ratio)
- previous PSAs helpful if available
- MSU
- Urinary tract US as appropriate based on history
- Assess for retention in macroscopic haematuria and seek urgent care if evidence of same

'Red Flag' items

• PSA over 20 in the absence of infection
