#### Name of clinical condition / presentation

- Haematuria

#### Indications for specialist referral

- Microscopic or macroscopic haematuria (sterile)

#### Referral information required

- nature of bleed and timing

#### Investigations required

- MSU to be included
- CT IVP preferable, US if IV contrast contraindicated
- UEC

#### Initial Management

- Assess for retention in macroscopic haematuria and seek urgent care if evidence of same

#### 'Red Flag' items

- Urinary retention
- Irritative voiding symptoms
- Presence mass lesion on imaging
