Indications for specialist referral

Microscopic or macroscopic haematuria (sterile)

Referral information required

• nature of bleed and timing

Investigations required

- MSU to be included
- CT IVP preferable, US if IV contrast contraindicated
- UEC

Initial Management

 Assess for retention in macroscopic haematuria and seek urgent care if evidence of same

'Red Flag' items

Urinary retention



- Irritative voiding symptoms
- Presence mass lesion on imaging
