➤ FREE FLU VACCINATION

A free flu shot will be available to all NSW residents in a month-long blitz from June 1 in an effort to combat this year's expected severe influenza season.

➤ CANCER SCREENING

The Healthcare Provider Portal provides a self-service alternative for health professionals to access and submit bowel and cervical screening data electronically in the National Cancer Screening Register. This can integrate with your software to make it easier to upload and check results.

Vaccine stock for the June flu blitz is available at TeamMed. Sites should expect a delivery turnaround of 2 - 4 business days.

➤ PNEUMOCOCCAL TOOL

The [PneumoSmart Vaccination Tool](#) has been created and managed by the Immunisation Coalition, using the pneumococcal disease vaccination recommendations in the online Australian Immunisation Handbook, and has been developed to assist GPs, medical specialists and other immunisation providers to comply with them. As pneumococcal disease vaccination recommendations change, the tool will be updated by clinical experts at the Immunisation Coalition.

➤ BEST PRACTISE SOFTWARE USERS

Best Practice Software users are advised to go in twice a year to extend their B2B Device. The default active period is 6 months only. An OMO needs to login to PRODA to re-set the expiry date.

➤ **ELECTRONIC PRESCRIBING**

The AMA recently met with representatives from the Department of Health, Services Australia, Australian Digital Health Agency and Medical Software Industry Association, and provided feedback on some problems faced by GP's with electronic prescribing.

➤ **NASH SHA-2**

If you renewed your NASH in March 2022 or earlier to SHA-1, you'll need to renew again to the new SHA-2 technology before December 2022. Log in to PRODA and HPOS and renew your NASH to SHA-2 as soon as you can.

➤ **WEB SERVICES**

Please complete your transition to web services in PRODA **by 19 June 2022**.

1. Log in to your organisation in PRODA
2. Add the Medicare Online tile to Services in PRODA.

➤ **SAFESCRIPT NSW**

Real time information about a patient's prescribing and dispensing history of high-risk medicines, is now active across Western NSW.

SafeScript NSW Electronic Requesting of Pathology –

To set up your practice for e-requesting of pathology tests:

1. Ensure you are using compatible software, and that your preferred providers can receive e-Requests from your software.
2. Once you have confirmed this, you'll need to contact your local pathology providers to have e-Requesting set up between your two systems.

For Sonic Healthcare labs (Douglas Hanly Moir and Barrett & Smith), you'll need to make contact to have the functionality switched on. Once this is confirmed, e-Requesting will happen automatically.

➤ **CHANGES TO THE MBS**

From 1 July 2022 there will be a number of changes to the MBS. These changes include implementing annual fee indexation, the Government's response to recommendations from the MBS Review Taskforce (the Taskforce) regarding colorectal surgery services and the Government's response to recommendations from the independent Medical Services Advisory Committee (MSAC) on pathology services, prostate-specific membrane antigen (PSMA) positron emission tomography (PET) services, abdominoplasty services and transcatheter aortic valve implantation (TAVI) services.

➤ **INDIGENOUS HEALTH PIP CHANGES**

Changes to the Practice Incentives Program – Indigenous Health Incentive, come into effect from 1 January 2023.

➤ **HEART CHECKS**

Heart Checks can now be performed on all patients from the age of 30. Previously, non-indigenous patients received heart checks from age 45.

➤ **CHANGES TO SUPERANNUATION**

From 1 July 2022, you will need to pay super to your employees who earn less than \$450 per month, provided they meet other eligibility requirements. This change expands super guarantee eligibility so that employees can receive super regardless of how much they earn.

➤ **APNA ONLINE TRAINING**

DVA has provided funding to the Australian Primary Health Care Nurses Association (APNA) for a capped number of fully funded training licences to Nurses and/or Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Primary Health Care Workers who have patients participating in the Coordinated Veterans' Care (CVC) Program.

The licences are for two online learning modules:

- Chronic disease management (2hrs)
- Care planning (3hrs)

Care coordinators need to apply before 21 June 2022 to access a training licence for free, however the modules can be completed at any time and at your own pace.

➤ **NATIONAL HEALTH PLAN GUIDE FOR PRESCRIBERS**

Arrangements for image-based prescribing implemented at the start of the COVID-19 pandemic ended on 31 March 2022, except with hospitals. Image-based prescribing will apply to the supply of pharmaceutical benefits for patients treated in public and private hospitals until 31 March 2023.
