# **Digital Health Updates**

### Check NASH for SHA1 and SHA2 here.

#### > NASH SHA-2

If you renewed your NASH in March 2022 or earlier to SHA-1, you'll need to renew again to the new SHA-2 technology before December 2022.

Log in to PRODA and HPOS and renew your NASH to SHA-2 as soon as you can.

#### > Electronic Requesting of Pathology

Some pathology laboratories that are connected to My Health Record will automatically upload results to My Health Record while others require eRequests for their reports to be shared. When Pathology eRequests are enabled in clinical software an electronic copy of the request is automatically shared with the testing laboratory, in parallel to the printed request to the patient, to improve orders and results processing.

## > Continuation of SMS reimbursement and the Electronic Prescription Fee

The Australian Digital Health Agency advises that the reimbursements of electronic prescription tokens sent via SMS will be extended until 31 March 2023.

Reimbursements will be provided for both the original electronic prescription tokens through prescribing systems and the cost of repeat tokens generated through dispensing systems.

The Department and the Agency maintain their commitment to the operation and evolution of the Australian electronic prescribing ecosystem.
