### Update on Schizophrenia/ Schizoaffective disorder and Clozapine Treatment

Clozapine is a key medication in Treatment Resistant Schizophrenia (TRS) but carries some risk to patients due to rare but detectable adverse reactions. The clozapine monitoring program is well established and effective, but GP prescribers require skills, knowledge and support to provide this vital medication to their patients.

Dr Amanda Trenaman will provide a brief overview of indications and benefits of clozapine in TRS and related psychoses.

Dr Tove Riphagen will provide an outline of procedures and potential pitfalls for GPs prescribing and monitoring clozapine for their patients.

Richard Young will cover information about support provided to GPs who are part of the clozapine monitoring and prescribing program.
