### Health alert: multi-drug resistant gonorrhoea

Two cases of multi-drug resistant gonorrhoea have been recently detected in Australia. NSW clinicians are advised to:

1. Take swabs for culture and antimicrobial resistance testing
2. Treat gonorrhoea with ceftriaxone 500 mg IM plus azithromycin 1g orally
3. Perform a NAAT test of cure 2 weeks after treatment.

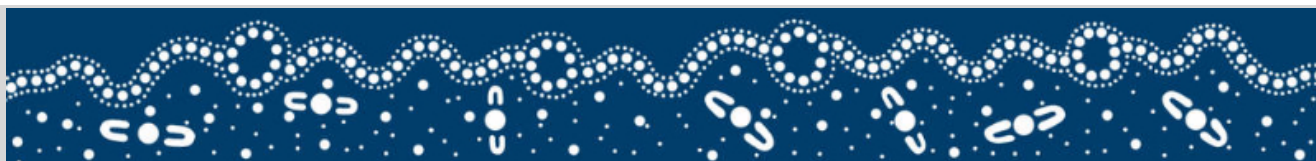
The My Health Record website has recently been updated to include a brand new “look and feel”, better compatibility with portable devices and updated information.
